

Public Information Session: Proposed Sydney Metro Martin Place Station development

Macquarie Group has submitted an unsolicited proposal (USP) to the NSW Government for the delivery of the new Sydney Metro Martin Place Station as a single integrated transport and commercial precinct. Macquarie is in the process of negotiating a final and binding offer that remains subject to NSW Cabinet approval.

In parallel to the USP negotiations, a State Significant Development Application will be prepared for the proposed redevelopment of:

- **North Site: 8-12 Castlereagh St, 5 Elizabeth St, 7 Elizabeth St, 9-19 Elizabeth Street, 55 Hunter Street and 50 Martin Place**
- **South Site: 39-49 Martin Place**

As part of the planning process, the public is invited to attend a series of drop-in information sessions to view the draft concept plan, meet the project team, ask questions and provide important feedback on the project.
